Organizational Orientation

- FQHC
- 27 clinics spread throughout 2 Counties (women's clinics, dental, homeless clinic, mobile clinics)
- Treating primarily Latinos (80%); farm workers and their families
- 60% MediCal, 35% uninsured, 5% private

Community Orientation

- 200% below poverty level: almost 50% in both Counties
- Uninsured in both Counties: 25%
- County Mental Health in both Counties restricted to the most severe mentally ill (MediCal)
- Merced County is HMO provider for MediCal; no contractors; similar in Stanislaus County

Integrated Behavioral Health Services: Public Health

- PHQ-2, DV, substance abuse, anxiety: 8 questions on the Adult Health History Form
- Posters in patient bathrooms with similar questions
- Educational campaigns include behavioral health conditions
- PCP training on behavioral health

Staffing

• 4 Licensed Clinical Social Workers and MSW intern

Psychiatrist

Range of clinical intervention

- Assessment-'second opinion'
- PCP extension- educate, elicit self management goals, advise, follow up
- Short term therapy
- Intermittent (long term) co-management
- Psychiatric consultation

Documentation

 Written communication- all notes for LCSW and psychiatric consultation are filed in the medical progress notes

 Verbal communication- in person when possibleimmediate when necessary for care;
